Halloween Color Day & Costumes

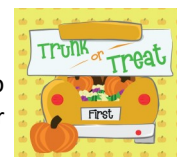


All students can wear their favorite Halloween shirt and non-uniform pants on Friday, October 30th. Color day rules apply. No donation to our mission is needed.
