**Principal's Report:** Enrollment is at 55 total students down 5 from last year. We have 16 students in preschool attending 4 days per week which required us to add an aide in the classroom per state law. **School Goals**- STREAM goal to be the first STREAM endorsed school by NCEA in 2021. A new marketing campaign is set to launch during Catholic Schools week. This will revolve around 3 phrases Academic Excellence, Eucharistic Love, Every Learner.

**Golf outing** income was steady. We are experiencing increased cost at Yankee Springs, decreased number of teams, donations were down. Looking for new volunteers to chair this event some interest from grandparents of students (Steins and Adamczyks).

**Teacher search:** We are still looking for an after school care provider (staff covering for now). The current teaching position is posted with Aquinas and Catholicjobs.org. The verbiage will be updated and reposted again in October. We are still looking for a middle school math specialist.
