### Water

We could use a donation of a couple of cases of water for those students who forget their water bottles.



I am very excited to announce that for the 2021-2022 school year, we will once again be using the student information system called FACTS for enrollment. Attached is a letter explaining how to log into your family's account and begin the process. There is a cost of \$30 per current enrolled student and \$40 for first time students in grades K-8th, this cost will be reflected on your first 2021-2022 tuition bill.

Tuition costs have been set for the 2021-2022 school year. A 2% tuition increase allows us to operate on a balanced budget and maintain our tuition at a rate less than other Catholic and private schools in Allegan county. The cost per child based on current enrollment is \$6,031.00 and tuition makes up only a portion of this cost. All other fees will remain the same.

**1 Child (K-8th)- \$3,986.00**

**2 Children (K-8th)- \$6,122.00**

**3 Children (K-8th)- \$7,812.00**

**4 Children (K-8th)- \$8,715.00**

This investment in your child's future includes \$66 family cleaning fee, \$140 book and registration fee per child. We will again be offering the opportunity for you to volunteer your time and receive \$300 in tuition credit by working either at the Polish Festival in August or the sub sale in February.

**Referral Credit-** *Don't forget about our new K-8<sup>th</sup> grade family referral credit of \$250.00 for our current St. Stanislaus families. The new K-8<sup>th</sup> grade family must designate the current family with the school office.*

**Daycare Options-** We will once again be offering Breakfast Buddies in the AM for our preschoolers from 7 AM to 8:30 AM, and Enrichment in the PM from 11:30 AM to 3 PM. We will continue to offer our afterschool care program for any student registered at St. Stanislaus School from 3 PM until 6 PM. The cost of this program is \$4.50 per hour and is billed monthly.



Our Fast & Feast Lenten Program is underway! This is an opportunity for reflection and prayer for all of our St. Stanislaus School students & families. On **Thursdays** during Lent, students can wear their Fast & Feast t-shirts. School uniform pants must be worn. Only solid, white, black or gray long sleeve shirts may be worn underneath. No donation to our Mission is needed.
